To All Members of the Nall Hills Homes Association,

As we move into the coming new year, we find that we have been met with a number of changes in the way that we provide trash services. Beginning January 1, 2012, we will be offering 3 different means of picking up and disposing of your weekly household waste. The information that we have included meets all of the requirements of the 2012 Johnson County Solid Waste Plan as well as those of the City of Overland Park. Please keep the following in mind as we work together to take better care of our environment:

- All regular household trash will continue to be picked up on your scheduled day, Tuesday or Wednesday, depending on your location. Trash will be limited to 3 bags, 3 cans or any 95 gallon kart or toter. Bags and cans should be no larger than approximately 30 gallon. Any additional waste that needs to be disposed of will need to be placed in a bag with a prepaid sticker attached. You can contact our office to purchase these stickers that are available in sheets of 10 for \$15. We have enclosed 2 for your use. They will also be available for the same price at Nuts & Bolts Hardware at 9628 Nall in Overland Park. If you would prefer not to purchase these stickers, pickup and payment arrangements can be made by calling our office where we accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.
- Recycling will be included in the weekly service that we provide and will be offered on the same day as your trash pickup, Tuesday or Wednesday. Every household will receive a 23 gallon recycling bin, but no limitations will be placed on the amount that will be picked up. Feel free to use your own well-marked containers in addition to your bin, keeping in mind that any container larger than 24 gallon requires a lid. Due to the demands of our recycling facility, recycling placed in plastic bags cannot be picked up. Bin deliveries are being scheduled for mid December. For those of you who already participate in our recycling program, please continue to use the bin you have been given and note that recycling will be offered on the same day as trash pickup. For your quick reference, we have included a simple list of recycling guidelines.
- Yard waste pickup will continue to be included in your weekly trash pickup and will be taken away on your regularly scheduled day of service. Please be mindful that it will now be picked up with the intention of composting and all bagged yard waste will need to be placed in bio-degradable bags with the tops rolled down to help eliminate spills. Limbs and branches will need to be bundled. Additional bags can be picked up by simply attaching one of the prepaid stickers. We have included the 2012 calendar as well as yard waste guidelines for your convenience. Please note that the shaded gray areas are weeks when no yard waste pickup will be offered. During the scheduled weeks of pickup for November and December, weekly limits will be increased to 10 bags or bundles to help accommodate for your fall leaves. - New for 2012 is a monthly bulky item pickup! This will be offered the first week of every month.
 You will now be able to set one large item out every month at no additional cost. This service will
 include such items as furniture (no longer than 5 feet in length), mattresses, box springs, bathroom
 fixtures...even the kitchen sink. Unfortunately, it does not include appliances. We are happy to
 dispose of appliances but there would be a additional charge.
