Deffenbaugh Industries 631-6300 The annual Nall Hills Homes Association meeting was held November 15, 2007 at Indian Woods Middle School, with 106 attendees and 53 proxies. Members enjoyed sandwiches, chips, Pop and cookies from Hy-Vee during the social time before the meeting.

President, Mark Sutton, welcomed everyone to the 51<sup>st</sup> anniversary of Nall Hills Homes Association. His opening remarks included the introduction of the board members as well as a summary review of the highlights of homes association events for 2007.

Erica Kurta read highlights of the minutes from the 2006 annual meeting, which were approved. Copies of the minutes in their entirety were available if anyone in attendance requested a copy.

Board members Dennis Wagner, Mark Able, Kurt McLoud and Debbie Burns presented committee reports regarding the Nall Hills marker replacements, finances and budget, 2007 baseball league results, civic affairs update and our website. Treasurer, Mark Able presented the 2007 projected financial statements and the proposed budget for 2008-2010, with a recommendation to increase 2008 dues to \$106. A motion to approve was received from the floor and passed.

The slate for the 2008 Board of Directors was presented and approved.

Door prizes contributed by area merchants were once again awarded to members in attendance, ending with the grand prize, one member's 2008 Nall Hills dues paid in full.

## Trash Pick-Up and Recycling Information

The Nall Hills trash contract with Deffenbaugh will continue to be the same in 2008 as it was in 2007. There is only one pick-up per week.

Your weekly trash pick-up is either a Monday or a Tuesday, the same as it was in 2007. Members should have their trash out by 7am on their designated day. Please remember that you should not have your trash out

any earlier than 24 hours prior to the pickup day.

Tree branches should be cut into lengths of four feet, tied in bundles, max 18 inches in diameter.

All other abnormal household items, appliances and some construction materials will require a special pickup (there is an extra fee for this service). For special

pick-ups, please call Deffenbaugh.

#### **Curbside Recycling:**

If you have a concern about a particular resident, Nall Hills members may contact our office and leave a message noting the house number and street where there is a concern and we will contact the resident and/or the city. The Homes Association sends courtesy letters to homeowners as appropriate.

**NOTE:** There was a change in the city ordinance this past year related to regulating the following:

1) parking, storage and use of commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles, boats and trailers. If you have any of these vehicles, we encourage

you to check with the city's website for all the details. The changes will be enforced.

#### 2) Rental Properties:

Owners of rental properties were required to register with the city by 12/31/07. There is an annual registration fee of \$10. Call 895-6270 for additional information.
