The annual Nall Hills Homes Association meeting was held November 9th, 2010 at Indian Woods Middle School with 94 homes represented and 55 proxies submitted. Again this year, members enjoyed sandwiches, chips, pop and cookies from Hy-Vee.

President Mark Sutton welcomed everyone to the 54th anniversary of the Nall Hills Homes Association. His opening remarks included the introduction of the board members and accomplishment highlights of 2010.

Secretary Hans Nettelblad read highlights of the minutes from the 2009 annual

meeting, which were approved by those in attendance.

Guest speaker, Skip Moon, Community Services Section Manager addressed members present and discussed restrictions and code enforcement, relative to homes associations and the City overall.

Treasurer Mark Able presented the 2010 projected financial results and the proposed budget for 2011-2013, with a recommendation to increase 2011 dues to \$154, due to the direct increase in trash service costs. A motion to approve the increase was seconded and passed unanimously by those in attendance.

The slate for the 2011 Board of Directors was presented and approved.

Committee reports by the respective board members present were delivered regarding the baseball league successes, civic affairs, neighborhood preservation, our share-a-repair program and website updates.

Door prizes contributed by area merchants were awarded to members in attendance, with the grand prize awarded to one lucky member whose 2011 Nall Hills Homes Association dues were paid in full.

Trash Pick-Up and Recycling Information

The Nall Hills trash contract with L&K Services will continue to be the same in 2011 as it was in 2010. There is only one pick-up per week.

Your weekly trash pick-up is either a Tuesday or Wednesday, the same as it was in 2010. Members should have their trash out by 7am on their designated day. Please remember that you should not have your trash out

any earlier than 24 hours prior to the pickup day. Tree branches should be cut into lengths of four feet, tied in bundles, max 18 inches in diameter.

Holidays in 2011 where trash pickup will be delayed one day: Memorial Day, Fourth of July and Labor Day.

appliances and some construction materials will require a special pickup (there is an extra fee for this service). For special pick-ups, please call L&K.

Curbside Recycling:

This is **not** included as part of your annual dues. L&K charges \$3.00 per month (bins will be provided). Call L&K directly to sign up – all recycling is picked up on Wednesday.

Rental Property

Owners: Owners of rental properties are required to register with the city. There is an annual registration fee of \$10. Call 895-6270 for additional information.

Did you know? Most residential burglaries occur during the weekday when homeowners are at work. Occupancy, or the appearance that someone is home, is the single greatest deterrent for burglars. Nearly half of all illegal entries into the home occur through an open or unlocked door, particularly an open garage door.

Large Item Pickup

This year, the City of OP will be sponsoring the large-item pickup for areas east of Antioch. As you know, in the years that OP doesn't offer this pickup for our area, we've arranged a private pickup for NHHA residents only.

The date for our pickup is March 26th, and you

should be receiving a flyer 2-3 weeks prior.

PLEASE READ - Solid Waste Task Force Update:

Preliminary information from the City of Overland Park and Johnson County Solid Waste Taskforce update indicates there <u>will be changes</u> in recycling and yard waste collections beginning January 1, 2012. Meeting agendas and draft recommendations developed by the Task Force are available for public view on the City's website at the following link: http://www.opkansas.org/Boards-and-Commissions/Detail/Boards-and-Commissions/Solid-Waste-Task-Force

Some of the issues addressed in the recommendations include bundling of recycling with household waste collection (with no ability to opt out in the fee structure), and yard waste pickup arranged separately for an additional fee. For those residents interested in composting to potentially avoid these additional costs, please visit www.jocorecycles.org for some very good instructional information; the County is also offering free seminars throughout the year on backyard composting.

These are some of the many issues the Task Force is reviewing that will affect all of us. The homes association board is in contact with the City and L&K Services regarding this action and will continue to monitor this situation. Obviously, there could be impacts to the annual dues in 2012 because of these changes. Be assured we will discuss the various options L&K Services plans to offer, and at what price, to determine the best solution for our homeowners.
